Press release

Alperia S.p.A./AG, a multi-utility company based in South Tyrol, 54.5% owned by the Autonomous Province of Bolzano, in compliance with the provisions of art. 2 of Provincial Law no. 14 of 10 October 1997 on the reorganisation of the energy system in South Tyrol, will proceed with the disposal of some (unconsolidated) minority interests in hydroelectric power plants with a capacity of less than 3 MW to the South Tyrol municipalities which are already shareholders in these plants.

This operation is justified by the reorganisation of the Alperia Group's portfolio, which sees the concentration of generation activities in major hydroelectric derivations and had already been announced to the markets in the prospectuses.

On February 22, 2018, the shareholders' meeting of Alperia S.p.A./AG approved this operation.

The production of the plants subject to disposal amounts - on an annual basis - to approx. 100 GWh. The closing of the disposals is planned during 2018.
