The Supervisory Board of Alperia S.p.A. today approved the Company's financial statements and Alperia Group's consolidated financial statements as at 31 December 31, 2025, the drafts of which were prepared and approved by the Company's Management Board on March 31, 2026. For the 2025 financial year, the Group reported revenues of approximately €2.4 billion, EBITDA of approximately €446 million, net profit of around €207 million, and investments of approximately €222 million.

On this occasion, in light of the net profit of Alperia S.p.A. amounting to approximately EUR 42 million, and following careful evaluation, the Supervisory Board also approved the Management Board's proposal regarding the allocation of the Company's profit for the 2025 financial year. This involves submitting a proposal to the Shareholders' Meeting regarding the distribution of EUR 38.0 million to shareholders as dividends, the allocation of approximately EUR 2 million to the legal reserve, and the carry-forward to retained earnings of the remaining amount of approximately EUR 2 million.

It is worth noting that the management report accompanying the consolidated financial statements also includes the Consolidated Sustainability Reporting.

Maurizio Peluso, Chairman of the Supervisory Board, commented: "Alperia continues along its development path with a clear and coherent industrial vision. Our strength lies in our ability to take a holistic view of the changes in the system – growing electricity demand, the central role of grids, the importance of renewables, and the need for flexibility – while combining industrial development, environmental protection, and the creation of value for the local community. In this regard, in 2025 the added value reached a record high of over €435 million, more than doubled compared to 2016. For the 2025 financial year, it was once again possible to increase dividends allocated to public shareholders (the Province and municipalities), for a total of €38 million.

This result takes on particular significance as it comes at the end of an important institutional cycle for the Supervisory Board. Over these years, the two-tier governance model has served as a safeguard for Alperia, ensuring fairness, transparency and accountability on behalf of public shareholders and the local community, while supporting major strategic, industrial, and organizational decisions.
